Official Records: The information on this evaluation form becomes a part of the official records of the NGCRC. This is particularly important for persons receiving certification: should you need proof in the future that you had a component of training on any specific subject, we could provide that proof due to the fact that we keep these records as a service to persons undergoing training.

This form is mandatory for persons receiving certification: because it provides a full transcript of the sessions you attended. You can sample from sessions: you can take partial credit for a session, write it down on this form. E.g., attending 1 hour of a 2 hour session, 30 minutes of a 1 hour session, etc "If yes, hours logged in 2 1/2".

Those persons registered for "non-certification" are also encouraged to submit evaluation forms.

Evaluation Forms can be returned on Wednesday, August 3rd, 2022 (or basically anytime when you have 24 hours logged in if you are registered for Certification). If you do not submit an evaluation form on or before 6pm, you will not receive your certificates: your status would be that of someone who did not complete the program. You need to make sure you have 24 hours logged in, there will be a "count" or audit when you submit your evaluation form. If you submit an evaluation form that does not indicate the minimum required training, you do not receive certificates: your status would be that of someone who did not complete the program. Evaluation Forms must be submitted to receive Certificates for persons registered for certification. Turn in your Evaluation Forms at the time of collecting your Certificates if you are receiving certification.

The Evaluation Forms will be collected at the Operations Center. The Certificates will be distributed as well at the Operations Center (the Garfield Park room on the third floor).

Some badges have unique identifiers that will help you. Watch for these.

A **RED** star on the Identification Badge indicates someone on the NGCRC's Goodwill Ambassador Staff; they also wear special easily identifiable uniforms; see them if you have any issue, or to report any problems with equipment inside the training rooms.
